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Clare's Handspun Cozy

This Hot Water Bottle Cozy was made for my lovely Auntie Clare, who had no requirement other than that it should be purple, which, there is no denying, it certainly is. The yarn was handspun by my Stitch'n'Bitch buddy Lynne (http://tasknitterspins.blogspot.com/) and was buttery and soft and tweedy, very nice. The stripes diminish in width from bottom to top, until they are only two rows wide at the top. An easy knit and a great gift.

| Measurements | Approx. 41cm high and 22cm wide |
|---------------|---|
| Yarn | Tasknitter Spins Purple Rain approx 100gms and Ladies in Lavender approx 100gms |
| Needles | 4.00mm circular |
| Gauge | 20sts and 30 rows to 10cm in stocking stitch |
| Other Notions | Large eye blunt needle, ribbon and buttons or beads |

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Cast on 84 sts and join for working in the round.

In colour A work 14 rounds stocking stitch In colour B work 14 rounds stocking stitch

In colour A work 12 rounds stocking stitch In colour B work 12 rounds stocking stitch

In colour A work 10 rounds stocking stitch In colour B work 10 rounds stocking stitch

In colour A work 8 rounds stocking stitch In colour B work 8 rounds stocking stitch

In colour A work 4 rounds stocking stitch.

Next round: Using colour A *K2 K2tog rep from * to end

Next round: Eyelet round: Using colour A K1 *yfwd K2tog rep from * to end

In colour B work 6 rounds stocking stitch

In colour A work 4 rounds stocking stitch In colour B work 4 rounds stocking stitch

In colour A work 2 rounds stocking stitch In colour B work 2 rounds stocking stitch

Repeat last 4 rounds until 2cm less than desired length ending with 2 rounds colour B.

Next round: In colour A Knit

Next round: In colour A *kfb rep from * to end

Continue in colour B:

Knit 1 round

Purl 1 round

Next round: *K1 kfb rep from * to end

Purl 1 round

Knit 1 round

Purl 1 round

Cast off loosely in knit.

To finish:

Using mattress stitch sew bottom seam. Thread needle through eyelet row and close with bow. Thread buttons or beads onto each end of ribbon and tie off.
